

In-Depth Proficiency Guide for updating and up skilling members with expired awards

An in-depth proficiency is skills maintenance. The member is required to complete the standard proficiency, following the "2013 Pre Season Information Pack" proficiency guidelines; PLUS the training and assessment of any identified gaps in the members Knowledge & Skills.

The table below has been developed to assist assessors (and trainers) with their gap analysis for members with expired awards. Some of the 'gaps' may be able to be trained and assessed at their in-depth proficiency. Others will require longer and may need to be scheduled for specific training/assessing session/s. For example – IRB awareness in BM; IRB in-depth proficiency for IRB crew and drivers; ARTC upgrade.

NOTE: Members whose award has not been proficient for 10 years or more; A full assessment must be completed, as per the relevant Assessment Portfolio. SLSNSW recommends that the member also attends the training sessions.
