COVID-19 Procedures

Audience: Surf Sport Managers, Club Secretaries and Team Managers, Sport Standing Committee.

Summary: This document contains important information about COVID-19 and the 2020/21 Season.

DISTRIBUTION OF THIS CIRCULAR - It is most important that the information in this Circular be brought to the attention of carnival officials, team managers, coaches and competitors.

ALL Clubs members and Attendees are required to follow COVID-19 Safe procedures and directives of FNC Branch COVID Officer and appointed COVID Marshalls

- Club COVID Marshalls are responsible for COVID Safe practices and 1.5m spacing in Club Areas
- For the purpose of Safety and Control, Entry to the Competition Area is Strictly Restricted to: Officials, Club Work Force, Competitors, Club Members (Team/Age Managers, Parents and Coaches) and Water Safety Personnel.
- ALL Persons MUST wear the Coloured wrist band **AT ALL TIMES** as evidence of COVID Sign in.
- If you are entering Cudgen Headland SLSC at any time you must complete the Service NSW QR Code additionally. Even if you are wearing the wrist band.
This is because it is a completely different venue to the Branch Championships 'bubble'.
- Each day you will be given a different coloured wrist band so you MUST check in on Sunday even if you have been at the event on Saturday.

5.30am – 7.15am Area Set by HOST Club

- Set up time for Host Club
- On arrival at Venue, respect NSW COVID-19 social distancing rules.
- **NO Entry to Carnival / Competition Area** excepting Host Club Work Party and Officials

6.30am SURFING: Officials & Competitors to meet Main Entry Gate to Area

- ALL will be required to have signed in or complete the QR Code for Event entry.
- Hand sanitiser will be present at the check-in table for you to use when you check-in.

7.15am Entry to Event/Competition Area – VIA the TWO Entry Gates ONLY

ALL will be required to use or have used QR Code and show Check Tick for Entry. This will be the myguestlist QR code.

- On Check In, with the approval of COVID-19 Marshall, you will receive a Coloured wrist Band.
- Wristband MUST be worn and evident within the Event Area at all times. NO Band – NO Entry!
- Tents/Gear/Craft set up in competition area via Entry/Exit point while maintaining social distance.
- Hand Sanitizer will be available at each of the Entry/Exit points.

8:20am Competition area to be cleared ready for Marshalling.

8:30am Team Managers Meeting
